Please follow the directions below for successful completion of this project.

Poster board should be 11" x 14" in size. Please nothing larger or smaller than this. Include the following information on your poster board:

- Choose a sporting event from the attached list.
- Write two facts about that sporting event. These can be historical facts, facts about the sport itself, or something fun you discovered about this sport.
- After watching at least one event from this sport, write two facts about the gold medal winner.
- Write one fact about the silver medal winner and one fact about the bronze medal winner.
- Be sure to include the country where each of the winners are from.
- Your facts can either be handwritten or typed.
- Be sure to include pictures (either drawn or from the internet).
- These will be displayed in the hall so make sure to do your best, neat work.
- ***This should be the student's work.*** Parents may assist in finding the information, but the student should be the one to write/type the facts and create the poster.
