

## Middle School Summer Reading Entering Grade 8

## **Summer Reading and Assignments:**

Both assignments are averaged together as one test grade for English. The averages are listed below.

**1. 50%** A book, of your choice, based on the **Holocaust**. It can be fiction or non-fiction, but must be at least 150 pages long. You may not read *The Diary of Anne Frank* or *The Boy in the Striped Pajamas*.

*Oral Presentation:* Your oral report must be 3-5 minutes. You must include the author, the title, a summary of the plot, and your personal recommendation. State whether you recommend this book, why or why not? You may use notecards!

2. 50% Historical Fiction: Choose either of these two novels:

Carry on, Mr. Bowditch by Jean Lee Latham **OR** Fever 1793 by Laurie Halse Anderson

*Journal:* In a spiral notebook or composition book, keep a diary as you read your book. For each chapter, you must write two paragraphs. The first paragraph needs to be a summary of the chapter. The second paragraph needs to be your reaction, your feelings, questions you have etc.

Be prepared the second day of school to share your oral report with the class
