4. List a few things you could do to help your child's weaknesses.
5. Based on your child's unique makeup, how do you think God may want to use him or her in a future vocation/career?
6. Besides you as parents, list the primary influencers in your child's life along with a brief description of how they influence your child.
7. What do you want your child's life to be like when he or she is 30 years old? (Think about their relationships with God, others, and themselves; their values; etc.)
8. What are you doing now to help your child become what you described in #7?
9. How should your child's school contribute to what you described in #7?
